




Take Effective Notes



	Greatest Common Factor (GCF)	For a polynomial, the GCF is the largest monomial that divides (is a factor of) each term of the polynomial.

	Quadratic Formula	The solutions of a quadratic equation in standard form $(ax^2+bx+c=0, where$ $a,b,and c$ are real numbers and $a \neq 0$): $x = \frac{-b \pm \sqrt{b^2 - 4ac}}{2a}$
Difficu	Ilt problems: front side	back side
	Example of using Quadratic Formula: 2x ² -10x + 7 = 0	$a=2, b=-10, c=7$ $x = \frac{-(-10)\pm\sqrt{(-10)^2 - 4(2)(7)}}{2(2)} = \frac{10\pm\sqrt{44}}{4}$ $x = \frac{10\pm2\sqrt{11}}{4} = \frac{2(5\pm\sqrt{11})}{2(2)} = \frac{5\pm\sqrt{11}}{2}$
