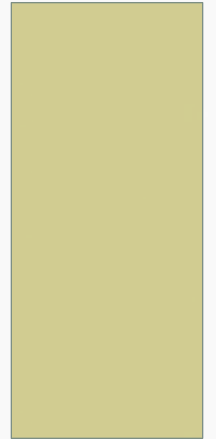

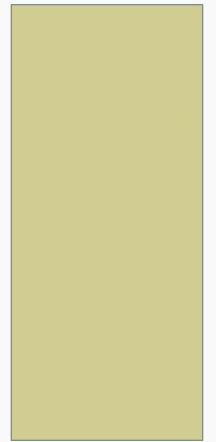

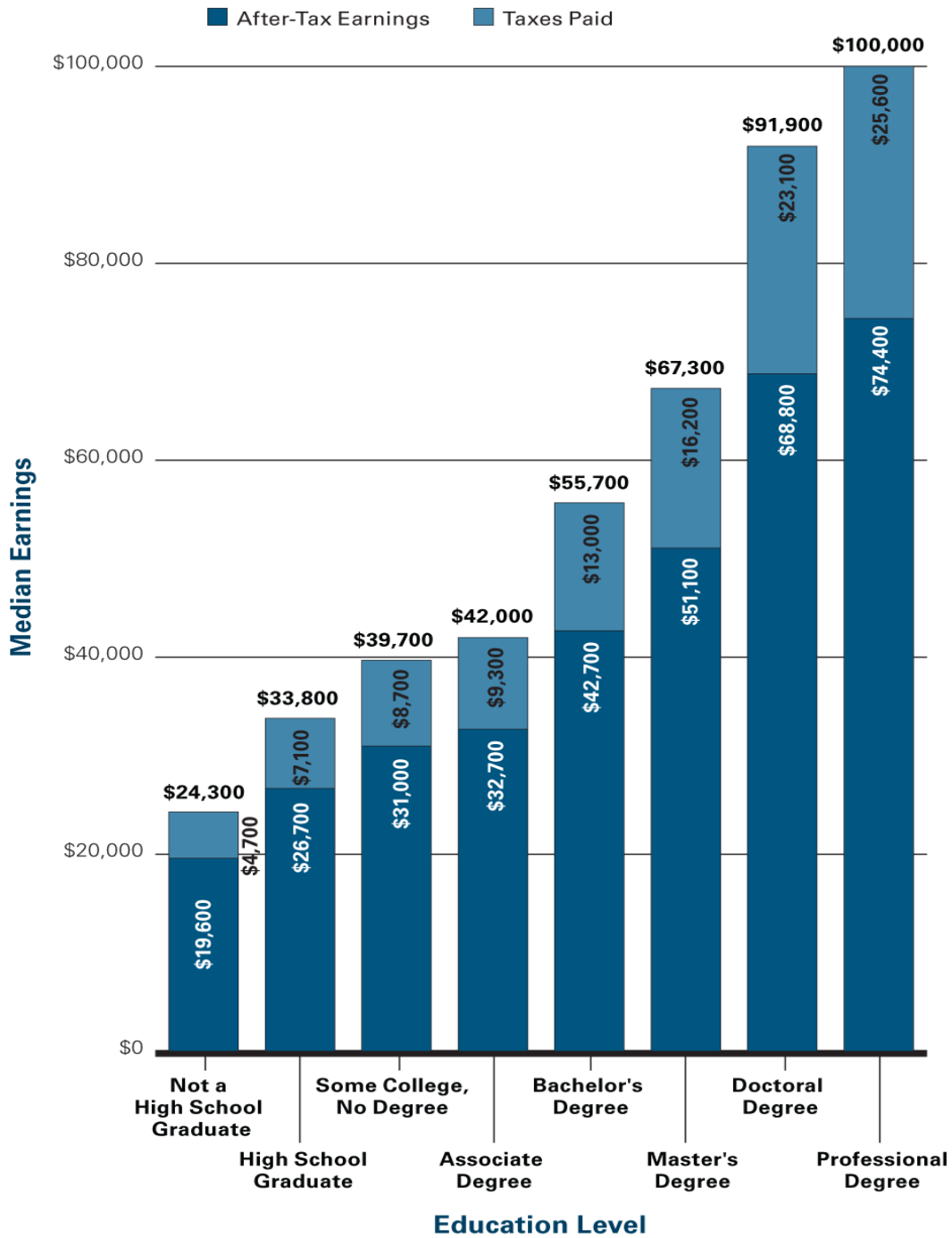


WHY GO TO COLLEGE?

- Greater wealth – more choices
- More security – provide for family, less likely to be dependent on others
- Better health – access to healthcare, leisure time to exercise
- Closer family – share experiences, pass on knowledge to future generations, role model for younger children in family, support parents
- Stronger community – more likely to vote, volunteer, and participate in community events

- Mas estabilidad economica- mas opciones
- Mas seguridad – proveér para la familia, oportunidad de independizarse
- Unidad Familiar– compartir experiencias, transmitir conocimientos a las generaciones futuras, modelo a seguir para los ninos mas pequeños, apoyar a padres y familia
- Impacto Comunitario– mas propensos a votar, ser voluntario y participar en eventos de la comunidad



TYPES OF COLLEGES

- Community college – 2 years, earn an Associates Degree
- 4-year college/university – earn a Bachelor’s Degree
- Technical schools – certificates for specific careers:
 - Cosmetology
 - Engineering
 - Welding

TIPOS DE ESTUDIOS UNIVERSITARIOS

- Colegio Comunitario - 2 años, obtienen diploma de asociado.
- Colegio de 4 años /Universidad – se obtiene una licenciatura/ o bachillerato
- Escuelas tecnicas - certificado para carreras específicas
 - Cosmetología
 - Ingeniería
 - Soldadura

COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Pros

- Lower costs
- Local, stay close to family
- Less demanding, more time for part-time work

Cons

- More than 50% students do not transfer
- Less learning opportunities
- Less rigorous, not challenging

COLEGIO COMUNITARIO

Ventajas

- Costo menor
- Locales, usualmente cerca de casa
- Menos exigente, permite mas oportunidad de trabajar a medio tiempo.

Desventajas

- Mas de 50% de los estudiantes no se transfieren a universidades
- Menos oportunidades de crecimiento
- Menos riguroso

4-YEAR COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY

Pros

- Prestige
- More courses and more rigorous course offerings
- More opportunities - student clubs, events, research

Cons

- Higher costs
- May have to be away from family
- More challenging coursework - less time for part-time work and other activities

COLEGIO/UNIVERSIDAD DE 4 AÑOS

Ventajas

- Prestígio
- Más cursos ofrecidos y opciones mas rigurosas
- Mas oportunidades – clubs estudiantales, eventos, investigaciones, viajar

Desventajas

- Costo mas alto
- Potencialmente mas lejos de la familia
- Cursos más difíciles
- Menos tiempo para trabajar

TECHNICAL SCHOOL

Pros

- Opportunities for higher pay depending on demand
- Work placement assistance from school

Cons

- Very specific - need to be sure it's what you like
- Little to no aid and scholarship opportunities

ESCUELA TECNICA

Ventaja

- Oportunidades de mejor salario dependiendo en la demanda de la profesión
- Escuela asiste a encontrar trabajo

Desventaja

- Muy específico –es necesario asegurarse de que es la carrera adecuada para usted
- Poca o ninguna ayuda financiera/bechas

HOW TO GET TO COLLEGE?

- A-G requirements – different areas where coursework must be completed (English Language Art, History, Mathematics, etc.)
- Advanced Placement (AP) courses – gives college credit when you pass the exam at the end = stronger college application, less time in college
- SAT/ACT testing – College admission requirement, some colleges have a minimum requirement
- Extracurricular activities – sports, volunteer, work, student clubs

COMO LLEGAR A LA UNIVERSIDAD

- Requisitos A-G - diferentes áreas en las que los cursos deben ser completados (Inglés, Historia, Matemáticas, etc)
- Cursos de Advanced Placement (AP) - dan crédito universitario al pasar el examen final= fortalece la solicitud universitaria, potencialmente, menos cursos requeridos en la universidad
- Pruebas de SAT/ACT- requisito de admisión para distintos colegios, algunas universidades tienen requisitos mínimos
- Actividades extraescolares - deportes, servicio comunitario, trabajo, clubs estudiantiles

HOW TO PAY FOR COLLEGE?

- Savings – start now! It’s never too early!
- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) – starting point for federal and state grants
- California Student Aid Commission (CSAC) and CalGrant
- Scholarship – free money! Check with local resources (San Diego Foundation, Rotary Club, Kiwanis Club, etc.)
- Student Loans – last resort
- Dream Act Application

COMO PAGAR LA UNIVERSIDAD

- Ahorre - empieze ahora mismo! Nunca es demasiado temprano!
- Solicitud Gratuita de Ayuda Federal para Estudiantes (FAFSA) - subsidios federales y estatales
- Comisión de Ayuda Estudiantil de California (CSAC) y CalGrant
- Becas - dinero gratis! Consulte con recursos locales (Fundación de San Diego, Rotary Club, Club Kiwanis, etc)
- Préstamos estudiantíles - último recurso, subvencionado y sin subsidio
- Dream Act Application
